Early Life

Neonate Life & Influence

Now known as DJ Fang, he commands respect in the vampire underworld through his magnetic presence, wild parties, and ability to blend music with his **Technomantic Sorcery**. As a proud Follower of Set, he carries the mark of the serpent god—marked by secrecy, subterfuge, and a seductive allure. While his sire's Setite sorcery remains a shadowy influence, DJ Fang focuses on his own path—melding nightlife excess with a growing hold over underground networks.

Current Day

In 2025, DJ Fang relocated to Atlanta, Georgia, where he is working to open his own nightclub, **"The Snake Pit."** The club's operations are managed by his loyal retainer and ghoul, **Seraphina**, who oversees day-to-day affairs and ensures the club remains a thriving hub of influence and excess. At The Snake Pit, drugs, alcohol, and vice are not uncommon, making it a magnet for the city's hedonistic and shadowy crowds.

Relationship with Vampire Sects

For DJ Fang, mortal influences shaped his development far more than formal ties to any Kindred sect. Instead, DJ Fang's focus has been on cultivating connections with influential individuals and groups in the mortal world, leveraging these ties to build his own unique influence.

However, his relocation to Atlanta in 2025 forced him to reconsider his independence.

- **Camarilla:** Recently, DJ Fang has aligned himself with the Camarilla. The move is less about loyalty and more about survival and strategy. The Camarilla provides legitimacy and protection from rivals who might otherwise view him as an easy target. Their influence also helps shield *The Snake Pit* from inspectors, police raids, and rival Kindred who would love to topple his growing empire. Additionally, some lingering debts and enemies tied to his sire, Kai Takahashi, make the stability of the Camarilla a practical refuge. Still, Fang isn't fully sold on the Ivory Tower—he plays along for now, but his allegiance is one of pragmatism, not conviction.
- **Anarchs:** Though he sympathizes with their rejection of hierarchical control, DJ Fang finds their ideals less relevant to his personal ambitions. He occasionally crosses paths with Anarchs during shared events but does not commit to their cause.
- **Independent Alliance:** DJ Fang respects their independence and operates similarly—focusing on autonomy rather than alignment. However, direct ties are minimal, as his priorities lie elsewhere.
